VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY Low-hanging Tree Branches?

Have you ever gone for a walk only to be grabbed by low-hanging tree branches over the sidewalk? Are you tired of having to duck and dodge those branches?

Perhaps you're thinking that because these trees are on city property you shouldn't be whacking at them. But the City would be thrilled if everyone just maintained the trees that are in front of their property. (If you have elderly or disabled neighbors it would be nice to tend to those trees, too - with your neighbor's permission.)

Low-hanging branches and overgrown bushes look sloppy, and they can block drivers' views, obscure stop signs., or even be a safety hazard.

Troy Schulte, KCMO City Manager, is eager to start a campaign with Volker possibly being the first neighborhood to address this problem. He said the City would provide training for the volunteers.

Groundbreaking for the KU Medical Center's new state-of-the-art **Health Education Building** at 39th Street and Rainbow is scheduled for Thursday, Aug. 27, with construction to begin Sept. 14. Construction is expected to last through June 2017.
